Adria Airways is Slovenia's national carrier and has a rich experience spanning over forty six years in charter and scheduled flights. Adria's history began in 1961, when it was set up as a charter company. In the eighties Adria Airways began offering services on scheduled routes and became a member of the International Air Transport Association (IATA). Today Adria's network links Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia, with more than 40 destinations (scheduled and charter), mainly in Europe.
